

Travel Tryout Guidelines 2017 (U12 and Under)

- 1) Academy Team tryouts will be conducted ***PRIOR to the CSL pool tryouts.*** Those tryouts for all age groups will be held INDEPENDENTLY of the CSL and placements/cuts will be determined **SOLELY BY SUSA!!!**
- 2) Players who do not make an Academy Team **MUST ATTEND** the CSL pool trout for their age group to be considered for placement on a CSL Travel Team.
- 3) CSL Pool tryouts will be held in June and will be conducted by representatives from our approved training organizations.
- 4) Tryout date/times will be posted and emailed out league wide beginning in Feb/March for BOTH Academy and CSL Travel teams.
- 5) Tryouts will be conducted over 2 days for each age group.
- 6) All tryouts are “blind” and each player will receive a unique number for the tryout. All players will be checked in prior to the first day of the tryouts for their age group and assigned a random tryout number. *Players are responsible to remember their number!!!*
- 7) At the end of the 2nd day of tryouts, each player will be “checked out” to make sure all numbers are accounted for and any “duplicate numbers” that may have occurred be clarified BEFORE leaving the field.
- 8) The tryout results **WILL BE POSTED ON THE CSL WEBSITE WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE TRYOUT FOR THE AGE GROUP.**
- 9) Once the teams are formed at the conclusion of the tryout, parent administrators will be assigned.
- 10) Anyone interested in becoming a parent administrator, must submit an application **PRIOR TO MAY 15TH!!** IF WE DO NOT HAVE ENOUGH PARENT ADMINISTRATORS, TEAMS **WILL NOT BE FORMED UNLESS** THE TRAINER ASSIGNED WISHES TO TAKE ON THAT RESPONSIBILITY **AT AN ADDITIONAL EXPENSE** ADDED TO THE FEES CHARGED TO THE TEAM DIVIDED EQUALLY AMONGST ALL TEAM MEMBERS.
- 11) After the results are posted by the CSL, **players will have 48 hours to accept/decline the position on the team by emailing the assigned coordinator with their decision. Players will then have 24 hours after accepting a roster spot to register through the CSL website for the fall season with that team.** If they do not register, after 48 hours, the next highest rated player will be offered a spot on the roster and **THEY WILL LOSE THERE ROSTER SPOT!!! THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY!!!**
- 12) The CSL Travel coordinators assigned to each age group will be responsible for overseeing the above procedure and contacting any players who have not accepted, declined, or registered. Once contacted by a coordinator, a player will have 24 hours to register. **AGAIN, ANY PLAYER NOT REGISTERED FOR THE TEAM THEY MADE AT THIS POINT IN TIME, WILL LOSE THEIR ROSTER SPOT.** CSL coordinators will submit the

finalized team rosters, the team name, and distribute all the registration information for all the players in their age group.

13) All teams names MUST NOT DUPLICATE and existing CSL Travel teams name.

14) FINALIZED team names, rosters, and coaches information will be submitted to the CSL Registrar WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE POOL TRYOUTS FOR THE AGE GROUP.
